The focus of this document is the creation of Product components for use with uniCenta oPOS in v4.2 and later.


Take things step-by-step and try not to feel too intimidated. Follow this guide and you won't go far wrong.

Useful things

Editor Toolbar


You will see this toolbar is used throughout uniCenta oPOS so here's a quick overview of what the buttons do. The Editor Toolbar appears in all record management forms.



Tooltips

Lots of things in uniCenta oPOS use pop-up Tooltips.

All you have to do is hover your mouse pointer over a component for a second and it will give you a brief description of what it does. Tooltips are constantly being added or revised as uniCenta oPOS development progresses.



BUNDLES

Product Bundles consist of a MASTER PRODUCT and associated, or sub-PRODUCTS.

Sub-PRODUCTS can exist and still be sold individually as well as being part of a collection, or as a component of a Master Product.

This is like a RECIPE in that a sub-PRODUCT can have a QUANTITY which can be either an individual or a proportional amount of the MASTER PRODUCT.

USING BUNDLES

EXAMPLES

AS PART OF A CASE

BOTTLES OF BEER

MASTER PRODUCT - Crate of Beer - has 24 bottles

Sub-PRODUCTS

Bottle of Beer – is $1/24^{th}$ of CRATE OF BEER which has to be represented as a numerical value 100/24 = 4.16666

AS A RECIPE

PIZZA

MASTER PRODUCT - Pizza Margherita

Sub-PRODUCTS

- Pizza Dough
- Olive Oil
- Crushed Tomatoes
- Basil
- Garlic
- Tomato Paste
- Mozarella

AS A KIT








CREATE THE MASTER PRODUCT

It might be a good idea to create a CATEGORY to group all Product Bundles to begin with. Sub-Products can exist in another CATEGORY along with other related group items.


The MASTER PRODUCT will not be visible in the Inventory: Current (inventoryb.rpt) report but the sub-Products will as they are the consumed units of sale.





The Inventory: Current report shows/tracks the sub-Products which is the UNIT component of a sale and it's not the MASTER Product

CUSTOMERS

- 1 Create a product 1 to be used for the Bundle.
- 2 Create a product2 to be used for the kit.
- 3 Create the Kit product itself to be used for building the kit
- 4 Go to the Product Kit menu and select your kit product that was created
- 5 Add the other kit products with the quantity you want. In this case I use 2x product 1 and 1x product 2
- 6 Generate a Inventory stock report showing current inventory
- 7 Sell one kit product that you just created

Generate another Inventory Stock report after the sale and note the differences.
